



Pamela Sweet Elizondo Memorial Scholarship Guidelines Winston Churchill Orchestra Booster Club

Funding

Scholarship funds to be raised through donations and Silent Auction conducted at the Annual Dinner Theater or as otherwise directed by the Orchestra Director and/or Booster Club.

Applicant Qualifications:

1. Graduating seniors currently enrolled in the Churchill Orchestra program.
2. Must have been enrolled and participating in high school orchestra for a minimum of four years
3. Parent or guardian must be a member of the Winston Churchill Orchestra Booster Club at the time of the student's application
4. Student must be enrolled in a post-secondary institution for the summer or fall of the year of high school graduation.

Selection:

1. Students must complete application as specified by Orchestra Director.
2. Committee of a minimum of four (4) WC Orchestra Booster Club members (not related to eligible seniors to be selected by Director).
3. Judging of applications will be conducted as outlined on student application form
4. Scholarships will be awarded based on funding and number of students applying.
5. Committee selections will be final, not subject to appeal.

Awarding of Scholarships:

1. Scholarships to be announced at the Annual Senior Concert
2. Affidavit to be provided to winners for signature by student and parent/guardian
3. Checks to be awarded to student upon receipt of completed affidavit from students
